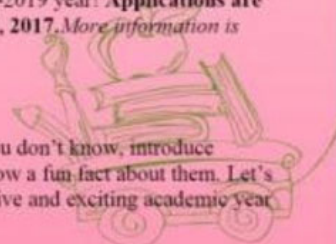
Hey, Language Residents,

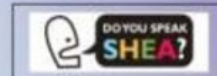
